

THE BRITISH CLEANING COUNCIL'S 2022 REPORT

Established in 1982, the British Cleaning Council (BCC) is the authoritative voice of UK cleaning, hygiene and waste industry. The BCC releases a research report packed with interesting and revealing facts and figures about the sector every year. Some interesting insights on the cleaning, hygiene & waste sector are revealed by the British Cleaning Council's 2022 research report, published 6th April.

The number of sector businesses grew to 69,005 in 2021 and the number of employees working in the sector remained static at 1.47 million. The number of people employed in the cleaning, hygiene & waste sector in 2021 was approximately 5% of the UK workforce:



the industry remains one of the top 10 biggest industries in the UK. According to the latest information available, the industry contributed £58.9 billion to the UK economy in 2019, up from the previous year, showing that it went into the pandemic in robust health. All subsectors, bar landscape service activities, saw a year-on-year growth in turnover up to 2021. This year's report says that the number of sector businesses grew from nearly

66,420 in 2020 but included a number of opportunistic firms which started up during the pandemic offering



cleaning services. The report said that the cleaning & hygiene industry directly employed over 941,000 people in 2021, 2% less than the previous year. The much higher figure quoted above includes cleaning across other industries such as public services and hospitality. Many BCC member organisations have also reported a greater interest in firms joining. A BCC survey of the sector during the first year of the pandemic demonstrated how variable the impact of Covid-19 had been on the industry, with some sectors and businesses seeing work drying up and staff going into furlough, while others saw a boom in demand. The new research also found that the cleaning & hygiene industry was quite competitive and nearly nine in 10 firms were micro businesses, employing fewer than 10 individuals. It also identified some challenges for the sector, including a record number of job vacancies. Employers in the cleaning sector need to adapt to a rapidly changing workforce if they are to win the 'frantic' battle for workers, it says. With 27% of the workforce aged over 55 years, the industry needs to do more to attract younger staff, the report says. In terms of training, it also highlights the 'good headway' made with the proposal for a Cleaning Hygiene Operative apprenticeship. A repeated request across all areas of the industry is the need for basic, entry level qualifications, the report notes.

"Clearly, we do not yet have the more recent figures which will show the full impact of the pandemic immediately and in the longer ter - BCC chairman Jim Melvin said - It also is possible that the decline in numbers directly employed by the industry in 2021 is the first sign of the current severe staffing problems, and next year's report will give a clearer picture".

THE DIVERSITY OF PARASITES OF BLACK **FLIES**

Flies in the order Simuliidae ("black flies") such as this fly in the genus Simulium, can carry blood parasites that cause the malaria-like bird disease leucocytozoonosis. While the parasites can't survive the human immune system to cause disease, bites from black flies can still be painful and cause unpleasant reactions in humans, such as fever, headache, nausea, and swollen lymph nodes. Black flies use their jagged mandibles to tear into flesh and then slurp up the pooled blood. And sometimes they leave a parasite behind. In a study published in the Journal of Medical Entomology researchers at

Mississippi State University looked for the presence and diversity of parasites from the order Haemosporidia in black flies and collected in their state. Their results were positive for haemosporidian DNA, and a closer look at the DNA sequences revealed that some of the parasites recovered in the study, species in the genus Leucocytozoon, diverge from those already in the database. Leucocytozoon blood parasites cause the malaria-like bird disease leucocytozoonosis and rely on flies from the order Simuliidae, known as "black flies," to transmit them from one host to another. It's a problem for both domestic and wild birds, who may show no signs of disease or experience mild to severe symptoms or even large die-offs. While the parasites can't survive the



human immune system to cause disease, bites from black flies can still be painful and cause unpleasant reactions in humans, such as fever, headache, nausea, and swollen lymph nodes. Beginning in 2008, more and more reports of human bites and backyard poultry deaths began to trickle into the Mississippi Department of Health and the Mississippi State University Extension Service. Experts noted black fly outbreaks in the years 2011, 2012, and 2018. End this is also a serious economic problem.


SOFIDEL'S FINANCIAL **RESULTS CONFIRM THE GROUP'S GROWTH**



In 2021, Sofidel's financial results return to pre-pandemic crisis levels and confirm the Group's steady growth. In fact, the second half of the year especially saw the consolidation of sales in Europe and – thanks to the new production capacity installed, at full capacity for the entire period - a significant strengthening in the United States. Essentially, after the extraordinary year of 2020 Sofidel resumed its path of steady growth even if – due to the strong impact of rising raw material prices and the

impossibility of reversing the impact on product sales prices – margins and economic results were partly affected. The Group has confirmed a consolidated turnover of over two billion euros (net sales of 2,095 million euros) and an EBITDA margin of 10.42% in a difficult context. Among raw material prices, the first half of the year was particularly affected by the price of cellulose, while in the second half the very sharp increase in energy prices (more in Europe, less in the United States) weighed on the cost structure. Sofidel Group CEO Luigi Lazzareschi confirmed that even in a difficult economic moment with a serious increase in the cost of raw materials, Sofidel strengthens its position and is competitive also thanks to its sustainability strategies. Edilio Stefani, Sofidel Group Chairman, added that the figures in the Sofidel 2021 financial statements are important prerequisites for continuing the path of innovation and transition to a low-carbon economy.

Sofidel in Italy agreements signed with RWE Renewables for the supply of wind energy and, in Sweden at the Kisa production site, with Meva Energy for the construction of a renewable gas production plant. On the subject of environmental sustainability, Sofidel joined the platform, "Forests Forward" launched internationally by the WWF. In the U.S. Sofidel America Sofidel has established a partnership with Ocean Conservancy. Among recent achievements is the addition of Sofidel on the CDP 2021 A List for combating climate change and the Platinum recognition received from EcoVadis for the approach to sustainability. COVID-19, THE IMPACT ON YOUTH EMPLOYMENT

Young people have been more strongly impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic than older people. The employement rate in EU young people (aged 15-29) in the third quarter of 2020 was -2.8 percentage points (pp) compared with the pre-pandemic third quarter of 2019. However, the third quarter of 2021 saw a recovery, as the employment rate was -0.1 pp compared with the third quarter of 2019. Comparing the third quarter of 2020 with the third quarter of 2019, all countries recorded a drop in their employment rate of young people. The largest decreases in the share of employed people aged 15-29 even exceeded 5 pp in Lithuania, Portugal, Ireland and Spain. On the other hand, Hungary, Finland, France, Austria and Romania reported decreases smaller than 2 p.p. In the third quarter of 2021, a majority of the EU Member States (16 out of 27) did not show full recovery yet, as the employment rate for young people was still below



the rate recorded in the third quarter of 2019. The largest decreases were recorded in Portugal, Bulgaria, Latvia, Czechia and Poland (all at least -3 pp in Q3 2021 compared with Q3 2019). In contrast, the largest increases in the share of employed people aged 15-29 in the third quarter of 2021 compared with the pre-COVID situation were made in Ireland, France and Slovenia (all at least +2 pp in Q3 2021 compared with Q3 2019). This data is being highlighted on the occasion of 2022 being the European Year of Youth (following the announcement made by President von der Leyen in her 2021 State of the Union address Commission has adopted its formal proposal to make 2022 the European Year of Youth).

COVID-19: WERE COMPUTER MODELS IMPORTANT FOR VACCINE DOSING?

For vaccine dosage decisions, past experience and best guesses have been very important in fighting the virus and modelling tools might have made a difference.

When Moderna joined the

hunt for a coronavirus vaccine in early 2020, the company had only limited clinical experience with its technology. Scientists tested the company's messenger RNA (mRNA) vaccines against certain viruses, such as avian flu and Zika, in humans. Higher dosages often triggered unwanted side effects, while lower doses did not always elicit a sufficient immune response. There seemed to be a middle ground: in a two-dose vaccine for another respiratory virus. So, it made intuitive sense for Moderna, based in Cambridge, Massachusetts, and its collaborators at the US National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Diseases (NIAID) in Bethesda, Maryland, to try something similar to tackle SARS-COV-2.

The problem in vaccine development was being fast, so being able to find useful dosages in a short time. Other efforts to develop Covid-19 vaccines followed a similar playbook. The University of Oxford, UK, in partnership with AstraZeneca in Cambridge, UK, started testing its vaccine - made from an engineered adenovirus - at a dose of 50 billion viral particles. It chose the dose in large part because that amount was used in previous trials of the same vaccine platform for other pathogens, including the coronavirus responsible for Middle East respiratory syndrome. This approach to dose selection produced several safe and effective Covid-19 vaccines in record - which has helped to save millions of lives around the world - but it did not necessarily take full advantage of the vaccines' pandemic-altering potential, scientists say. A growing number of scientists think that the industry can do better. With an eye towards optimizing immune responses, they have been developing mathematical and computational models over the past several years to inform dose decisionmaking for vaccine trials. Not everyone is convinced the models are ready for prime time; many aren't even aware that the platforms exist. But those who embrace the technology say that, if companies had simply capitalized on all the tools at their disposal, Couid-19 vaccines might be doing an even better job at containing viral spread and limiting collateral damage. Pharmaceutical companies have long used computational modelling strategies to fine-tune drug dosing, but such techniques have rarely been applied to vaccine development.

EU-OSHA: GOOD PRACTICE AWARDS

Good Practice Awards showcase strong commitment to preventing and managing musculoskeletal disorders.

As part of its 15th Healthy Workplaces EU_OSHA: Good Practice Awards competition, the European Agency for Safety and Health at Work (EU-OSHA) recognises 8 winning and 8 commended examples that successfully tackle musculoskeletal disorders (MSDs). Companies and organisations from all over Europe are demonstrating the many benefits of a safer and healthier workplace when everyone gets involved.

Active participation is where the workers who do the jobs are involved in both identifying the MSD risk factors and proposing preventive measures. William Cockburn, EU-OSHA Interim Director One of the main highlights of EU-OSHA's Europewide Healthy Workplaces Lighten the Load campaign, the awards acknowledge small and large companies and organisations from various industries in Europe that actively prevent and manage MSDs through effective occupational safety and health (OSH) management approaches.

EU-OSHA Interim Director William Cockburn commented on the need to involve workers in MSD risk assessment and prevention: 'Active participation is where the workers who do the jobs are involved in both identifying the MSD risk factors and proposing preventive measures. Workers have detailed knowledge of and experience in how the job is done and how it affects them. They should be involved in all stages of MSD risk prevention.'

THE FOLLOWING EIGHT ORGANISATIONS WERE AWARDED:

- Universitätsklinikum AKH Wien, the largest hospital in Austria, successfully involved workers in developing measures to prevent MSDs:
- Swissport Cyprus Ltd tested, further developed and purchased a state-of-the-art suit (wearable exoskeleton) to better manage manual handling at Larnaka and Paphos International Airports;

• German multinational software corporation SAP SE developed a comprehensive knowledge database to promote ergonomics and prevent MSDs;

- F&F Ltd, a family-run sweets factory in Hungary, planned and designed technical modifications for its production line based on ergonomic principles to improve OSH conditions and to reduce MSDs;
- Servizi Italia Spa, a provider of laundry and sterilisation services to the healthcare sector, introduced innovative operating methods and instrumental changes in its plants to prevent MSDs while improving awareness of and knowledge about ergonomic risks;
- the Latvian metalworking company SIA
 Silkeborg Spaantagning Baltic created a
 safe and ergonomic workplace with the help
 of employees by using practical solutions to
 handling and lifting heavy loads;
- UAB Vonin Lithuania is a professional fishing equipment manufacturer that minimised operators' shoulder sprain during their shifts after carrying out company-wide ergonomics training;
- the Slovenian insurance company
 Zavarovalnica Triglav, d. d. developed a
 strategic approach to OSH so that employees
 have the best physical and mental health
 possible.

A further eight organisations were commended: the building materials company Rohrdorfer Transportbeton GmbH from Austria; GZA Ziekenhuizen hospitals from Belgium; Suomen Nestlé Oy, a Finnish children's food factory; Siun sote-Municipal authority social and health services for North Karelia from Finland; the Italian yarn company Zegna Baruffa Lane Borgosesia **SpA**; the Dutch cleaning services company **Hago** Next; Verdonk Broccoli, a vegetable growing company from the Netherlands; and the Spanish meat company Elaborados Julián Mairal sl. Trophies for the awarded organisations and certificates for the commended organisations will be given out in a special ceremony at the Healthy Workplaces Summit in Bilbao, Spain, in November 2022. All examples will be published as case studies and in a booklet in the coming months.

A DIFFERENT APPROACH TO MALARIA DATA

Malaria is an acute febrile illness caused by *Plasmodium* parasites, which are spread to people through the bites of infected female Anopheles mosquitoes. There are 5 parasite species that cause malaria in humans, and 2 of these species - *P. falciparum and P. vivax* - pose the greatest threat. *P. falciparum* is the deadliest malaria parasite and the most prevalent on the African continent. *P. vivax* is the dominant malaria parasite in most countries outside of sub-Saharan Africa.

A recent article in *The Lancet* presents a different landscape of WHO data on malaria. The WHO Global Malaria Programme has provided clear and compelling narrative based on the best available data and methods.

However, in accordance with best practices, the estimates change each year across the time series. In sub-Saharan Africa, where 98% of global malaria mortality occurs, the WHO Maternal Child Epidemiology Estimation group quantifies a cause of death. In 2021, WHO published new estimates of cause of death using a different approach.

The comparison of changes in the malaria deaths of 2000 versus 2019, between the old and new methods, are 45% versus 38%. If the global malaria incidence and mortality rate in 2000 were applied to populations at risk annually to 2020, the investments made over the past 20 years would have contributed to an estimated 11 million lives saved and 1·7 billion cases averted since 2000.

DIFFERENT ESTIMATES

In sub-Saharan Africa alone, there could have been an estimated 360 million cases in 2020,



instead of the current estimated 219 million cases. Simply comparing the 241 million cases estimated at baseline in 2000 and 2020, the first year of the Couid-19 pandemic, misses these important perspectives.

Since 2015, however, progress has stalled, and the reasons are complex. In sub-Saharan Africa, more people live in areas of risk of malaria, where funding has plateaued, coverage of vector control interventions has flattened or declined, and access to quality care is inadequate. Available tools are compromised by biological threats.

What should be done? Investing now, efficiently, and equitably in malaria and health systems can lead to a great return and will guard against future threats.

GREEN IN HOUSEKEEPING

Housekeeping is at the frontline of any hotel business. Their contact with guests and their presentation of rooms for guest appreciation is of utmost importance. It is necessary to train the teams to learn company values when it comes to cleaning green: having ecofriendly products and processes in place is of no value if staff aren't making use of them. Each employee has individual beliefs in regards to environmentally friendly practices, therefore it is important for hotels to offer training for their staff. This way it will assist hotels to conserve water that might otherwise be wasted when leaving taps open while cleaning and by unnecessary flushing of toilets. Hotels can focus on a number of areas when it comes to training their staff, this includes water management, energy efficiency, waste segregation and recycling. Use products with less packaging: anyone who has stayed in a hotel will



be familiar with the packing material of tiny guest amenities. Often neatly boxed, once the box is open, the item is still packed in a plastic sleeve: will just be thrown away, ending up in a garbage dump or landfill. Hotels should choose supplier companies that use environmentally friendly packaging. Reducing your water consumption is also important: you don't need to change sheets and towels every day. Therefore, many hotels have adopted a sustainability policy in which the guest has the option to opt-out of the daily change of linens. and then, of course, use eco-friendly products which come as concentrates - including disinfectants, glass and window cleaners, liquid soaps, degreasers, laundry detergents and many more.

ANTIBIOTICS AND COVID-19

Antibiotics are not effective treatment for viral infections, including COVID-19. However, in a recently released JAMA (Journal of American Medical Association) research letter, Antibiotic prescriptions associated with COVID-19 outpatient visits among Medicare beneficiaries, April 2020–April 2021, CDC authors found that during the first year of the COVID-19 pandemic (April 2020-April 2021), 30% of outpatient

visits for COVID-19 among Medicare beneficiaries were associated with an antibiotic prescription. Azithromycin was the most frequently prescribed antibiotic (50.7%), followed by doxycycline (13.0%), amoxicillin (9.4%), and levofloxacin (6.7%). Prescribing rates were highest for emergency department (33.9%) and telehealth encounters (28.4%). Non-Hispanic, White beneficiaries were prescribed antibiotics at a higher rate than African-American or Black beneficiaries.

Antibiotics, including azithromycin, are not effective treatment for COVID-19 and should not be prescribed to most outpatients with viral infections. Anytime antibiotics are prescribed, they can lead to adverse drug events and contribute to antibiotic resistance, an urgent public health threat. Findings from this study reinforce the importance of improving appropriate antibiotic prescribing in outpatient settings and avoiding unnecessary antibiotic use for viral infections, including COVID-19, in older adult populations.

10 ICONIC ARTWORKS TO SEE IN AND AROUND AMSTERDAM

There is more than one reason that The Night Watch get its own room in the Rijksmuseum: not only is the painting gigantic (3.63 by 4.37 metres, or nearly 12 by 14 feet), it's gigantically famous. At any given moment is the Night Watch Gallery, which was designed solely to showcase the painting, packed with dozens of eager viewers. Join the throng to admire all the details the iconic painting - and the room itself.

Not many works of art are so captivating that they get a book and a movie made about them – but Girl With a Pearl Earring is one of them. Created in the mid-17th century by Johannes Vermeer, this work of art - called a tronie, an old Dutch word for "face" - features the alluring gaze of a young girl in a headscarf and Eastern dress. The Mauritshuis Museum has had the painting for over 100 years, and it's unlikely to part with it - so don't miss out on seeing this masterpiece in person!

Vincent van Gogh is arguably the most famous of Dutch artists, and his series of sunflowers are among his most celebrated. In the Van Gogh Museum, you get the chance to see one of the five in the series - the rest of these golden masterpieces are scattered across the globe.

The red, blue and yellow squares separated by thick black lines has become an iconic, easily recognisable work of art - it's all Mondrian. There are dozens of iterations on the theme, but this classic representation is one of the best. Visit this icon at the Stedelijk Museum in Amsterdam, which proudly displays modern and contemporary art. Alternatively, take a short trip to The Hague to see Mondrian's iconic Victory Boogie Woogie.

STEDELIJK MUSEUM, AMSTERDAM

Like Warhol, American artist Roy Lichtenstein brought pop art into fine art prominence. His piece As I Opened Fire is a great example of his unique style: derived from a comic book, this work features three panels, called a triptych, alongside exaggerated lettering, the use of primary colours and the narrative from the comic itself, albeit slightly altered.

STEDELIJK MUSEUM, AMSTERDAM

Rembrandt honed his craft by painting self-portraits - a fascinating opportunity for viewers to see artists through their own eyes. Some of Rembrandt's most famous self-portraits feature cartoonish expressions or, in this case, a deep fascination with chiaroscuro, in which the artist plays with light and shadows.

INFORMATION ABOUT COVID-19

Amsterdam's public venues are currently open, with normal opening hours. A Couid entry pass is not mandatory to access public indoor spaces. Keeping 1.5 metre distance is not required, but recommended. Always check the website of the venue or event for the latest news before your visit.
